

Artwork to supply

Option 1

The artwork we need you to supply can be done on white paper or tracing paper. Once the drawings / designs have been done in pencil and the artist / participant is happy with the shape and design they then need to go over it with black felt pen to produce solid black shapes. Please remember to rub out the pencil drawing after the ink has dried. Shown below is the final design as solid black shapes.



For the final stencil I have outlined the black shapes which you can see in the pic on the right of final sandblasted product.

The black shapes in the drawing supplied are raised and the white shapes within are sandblasted.

Another outcome would be to have the black shapes sandblasted



Option 2

Black outlines only.

Once the drawings / designs have been done in pencil and the artist / participant is happy with the shape and design they then need to go over it with black felt pen to produce solid black outlines. Shown below is outlined artwork at the size it was supplied 140mm x 140mm. If you worked with A5 pieces of paper and a permanent black marker pen that would work well as a standard size.

If drawing are done with a thin pen then the size to work with is a square post it note which is 80mm x 80mm.

Other things to consider are - Do you want to add the initials and age of the artist. Do you want to say something rather than submit an image.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO RUB OUT THE PENCIL DRAWING AFTER THE INK HAS DRIED.



Materials you will need for creating the artwork.

1. Thick non bleeding paper, card or tracing paper around 120gm for the artwork to be drawn on to. Cut paper into A4 or A5

2. Pens as shown in pic below. If you are working with small pieces of paper then the finer nib pen would be suitable. A5 size paper use a medium nib pen, A4 size paper use a larger thick marker pen.

Please don't supply anything bigger than A4.

PS DESIGNS SHOULD NOT GO TO THE EDGE OF THE PAGE, A CLEAR MARGIN ALL AROUND THE EDGE PLEASE.
