You must send two copies of the Notice to the address above **AT LEAST TEN WORKING DAYS BEFORE THE PROPOSED EVENT**, and one copy to the Police. Section 193 of the Act defines "Working day" as any day other than a Saturday, a Sunday, Christmas Day, Good Friday, or a day which is a Bank Holiday under the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971 in England and Wales. "Ten working Days" notice means ten working days exclusive of the day on which the event is to start, and exclusive of the day on which notice is given.
