#### Title of the plan the council proposes to submit to the Secretary of State

The Plan for the Borough of Wellingborough – Publication Plan: Part 2 of the Local Plan

#### Subject matter and area covered

The plan comprises non-strategic housing allocations, defines Village Boundaries, identifies policies for the protection and provision of open space and contains development management policies. It will be used to guide development (along with the adopted North Northamptonshire Joint Core Strategy which comprises the local plan part 1) in the determination of planning applications in the Borough of Wellingborough up to 2031.
