

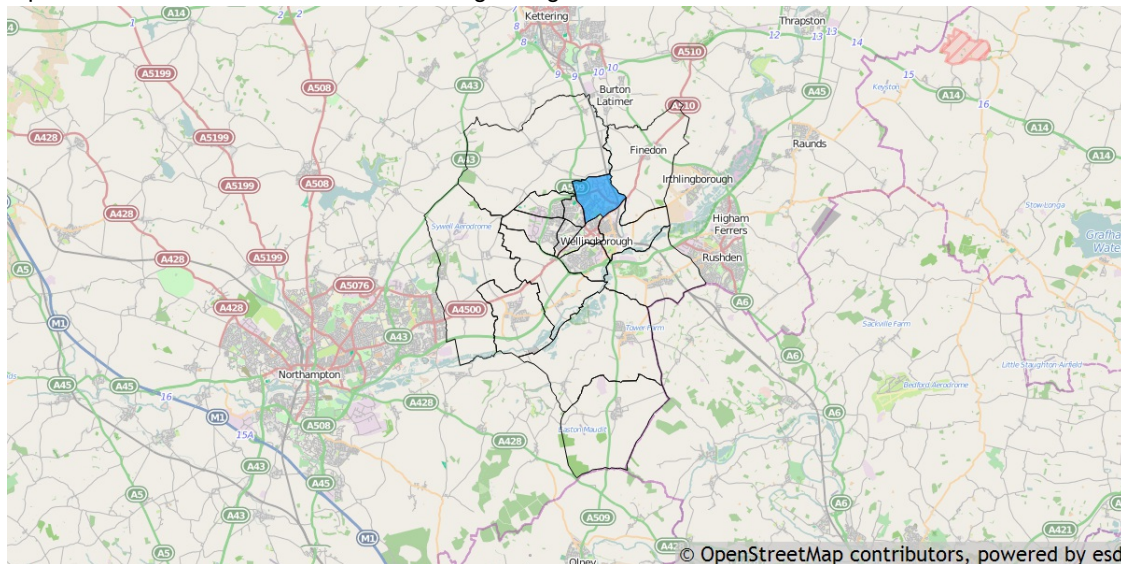
## Basic facts about Hemmingwell Ward

This report provides a summary of the latest available information on the demographic and socio-economic make-up of the Hemmingwell Ward within Wellingborough. It looks at the population structure and provides information on the economic, housing and educational achievement of the Ward.

Hemmingwell is one of the 16 Wards of Wellingborough. It has an area of 386 hectares which represents 2.37% of the total area of Wellingborough District.



### Residents

Hemmingwell has a resident population of 8,272 which represents 10.98% of the total Wellingborough resident population of 75,356.

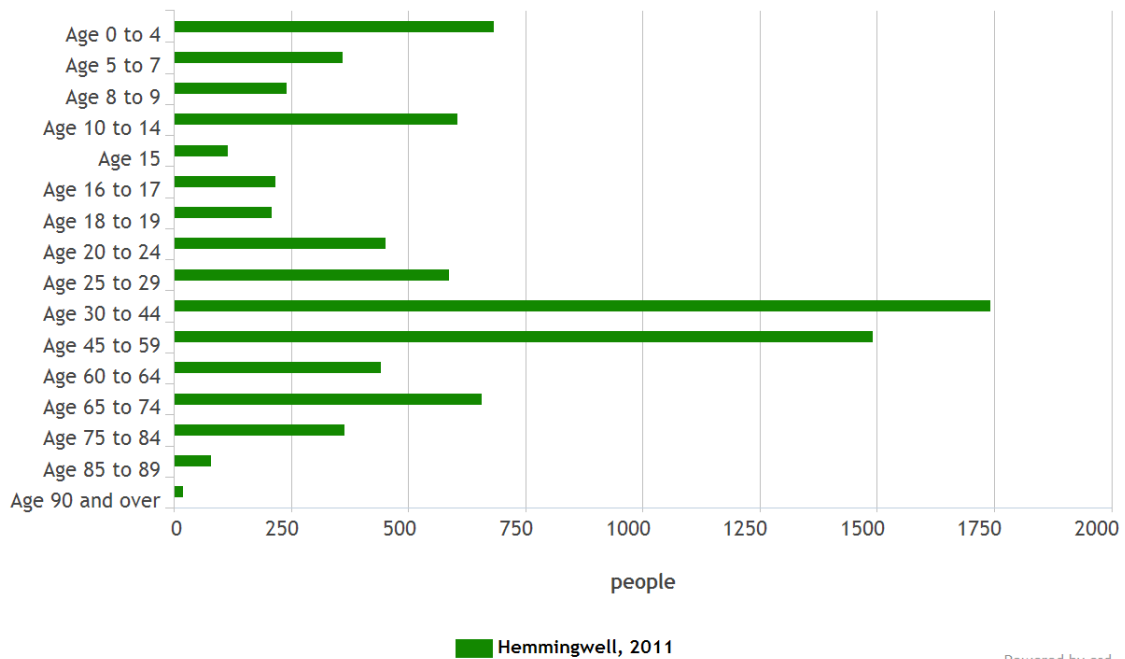
Hemmingwell's resident population is 51.4% female and 48.6% male.

### Age

The mean age of the Hemmingwell Ward population is 36 years compared to a mean age of 40 years for residents in the whole of Wellingborough. The predominant age band in Hemmingwell Ward is Age 30 to 44 which represents 21.10% of the population.

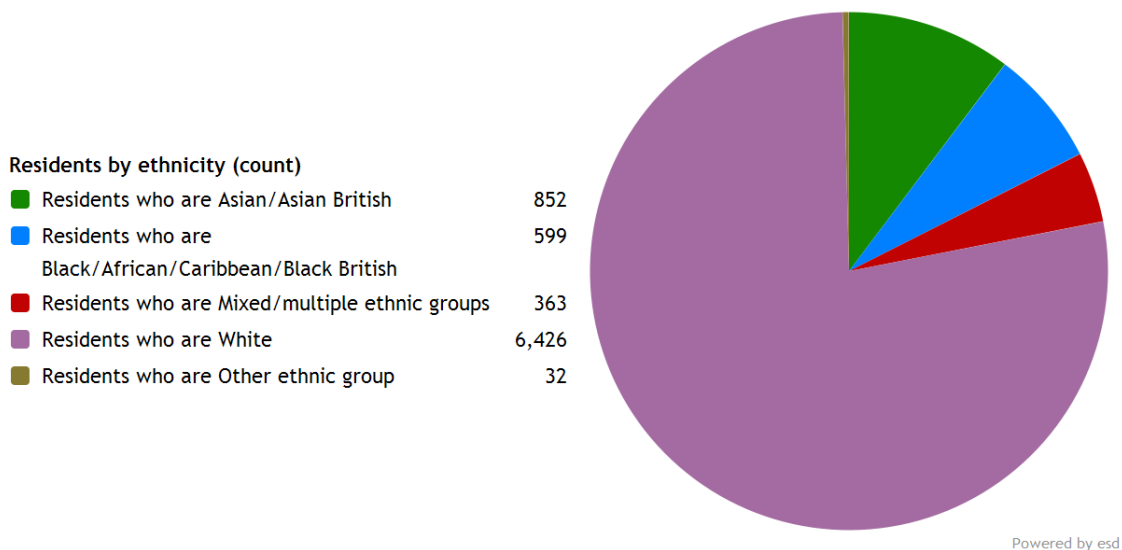


## Ethnicity

The largest ethnic group is 'Number of usual residents who are White' with 77.7% of the Ward's population. That compares with a figure of 87.3% for the District as a whole, 91.5% for the Northamptonshire County and 89.3% for all of East Midlands.

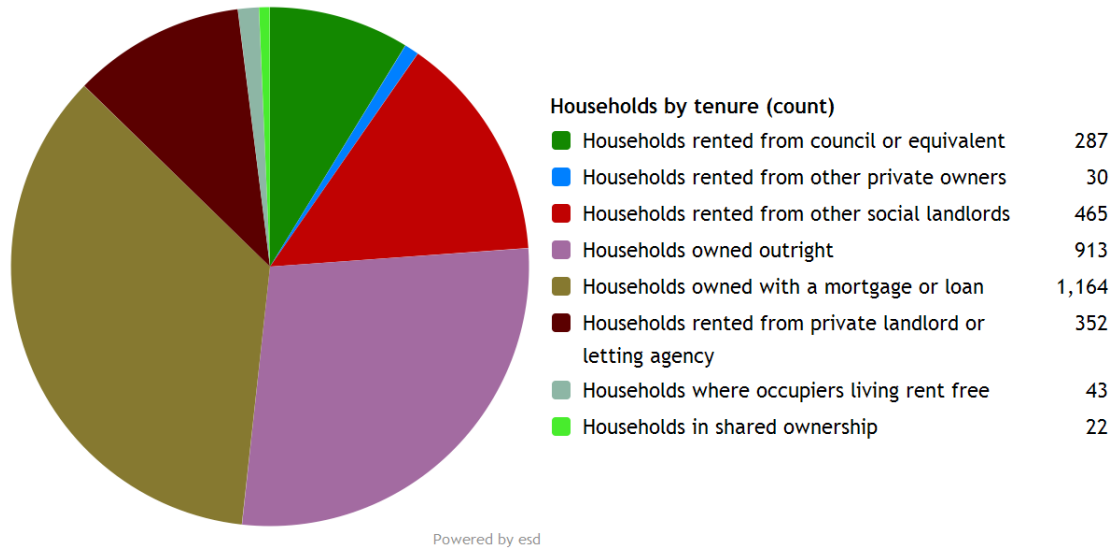
The second largest ethnic group is 'Number of usual residents who are Asian/Asian British' with 10.3% of the Ward's population. That compares with 5.9% for the District as a whole, 6.5% for the Northamptonshire County and 7.8% for all of East Midlands.

## Households

Hemmingwell Ward has 3,276 households, which represents 10.22% of Wellingborough's 32,057 households. The household split by tenure is shown below.



The largest number of households lives in 'Number of all households - Owned with a mortgage or loan' accommodation with 35.5% of the Ward's households. That compares with 36.5% for the District as a whole, 38.7% for Northamptonshire County and 34.7% for the whole of East Midlands.

The second largest number of households lives in 'Percentage of all households - Owned outright' accommodation with 27.9% of the Ward's households. That compares with 29.9% for the District as a whole, 29.1% for Northamptonshire County and 32.9% for the whole of East Midlands.

The Ward has 526 households with dependent children aged 0 to 4. That represents 16.10% of the Ward's households.

1,214 households in the Ward have 'Dependent children in household: All ages'. That represents 37.10% of the Ward's households.

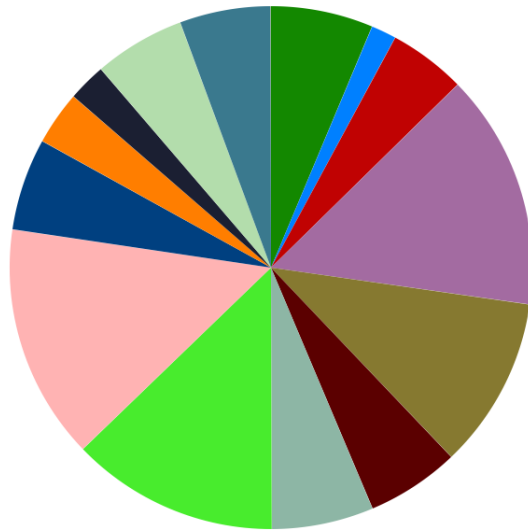
## Employment

The following chart provides a breakdown of the Hemmingwell Ward by socio-economic classification for all residents aged 16 – 74.

The National Statistics Socio-economic Classification (NS-SEC) provides an indication of socio-economic position based on occupation. It is an Office for National Statistics standard classification. To assign a person aged 16 to 74 to an NS-SEC category their occupation title is combined with information about their employment status, whether they are employed or self-employed, and whether or not they supervise other employees. Full-time students are recorded in the 'full-time students' category regardless of whether they are economically active or not.

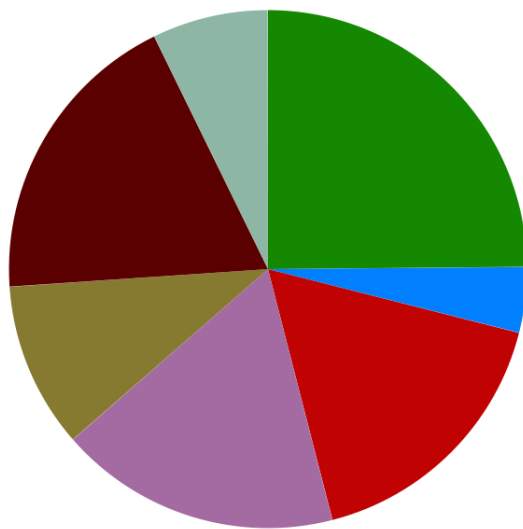

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The largest group is 'National Statistics Socio-Economic Classification - 2. Lower managerial, administrative and professional occupations' representing 17.70% of the Ward's population.

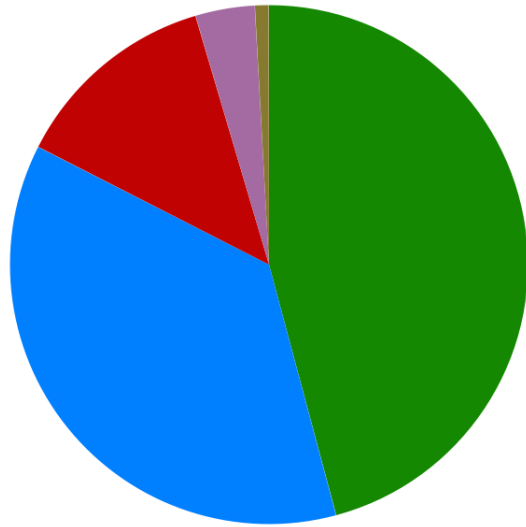
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18.90% of Hemmingwell 's residents have achieved level 4 qualifications and above compared to 23.60% in East Midlands as a whole and 24.90% of Hemmingwell 's residents have no qualifications compared to 24.70% in East Midlands .

## Health

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Hemmingwell has 308 (3.7% ) residents that report being in bad health and 71 (0.9% ) residents that report being in very bad health.

Its ranking for the number of residents in very bad health is 6 (out of 16 Wards) within Wellingborough.
