Mears Ashby Village Design Statement Supplementary Planning Document

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Wellingborough resolved to adopt the Mears Ashby Village Design Statement Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 23 February 2017. This document was adopted in accordance with section 23(1) of the above Act, taking into account representations made in relation to the document, and modified as a result of those representations.

The Village Design Statement has been prepared to identify the most important characteristics of Mears Ashby and provide guidelines to steward appropriate development in keeping with the local environment. It supplements policies in the North Northamptonshire Joint Core Strategy by helping to define local character.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the supplementary planning document may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the supplementary planning document was adopted, in this case 23 February 2017.
