

**Adoption Statement**  
**Air Quality and Emissions Mitigation Supplementary Planning Document**

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Wellingborough resolved to adopt the 'Air Quality and Emissions Mitigation Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)' on 18 January 2021. This document has now been adopted in accordance with section 23(1) of the above Act, taking into account representations made in relation to the document, and modifications made as a result of those representations where appropriate.

The SPD provides advice on air quality issues relating to planning applications in the borough. It supports Policy 8 of the North Northamptonshire Joint Core Strategy and the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) in seeking to ensure that new development does not detrimentally impact on air quality and in meeting the councils climate change agenda.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the supplementary planning document was adopted; in this case by 18 April 2021.
